
# Parent / Teacher Consultations - Monday 12th March

Parents and carers will also have an opportunity to taste samples of our menu during the afternoon too!



## Nursery

## Reception

Our topic this term is Superheroes! Reception Class have already begun designing masks and thinking of different super powers. We have inferred information from our text Superkid by Claire Freedman. We have talked about what special powers Superkid might have and how he might save the day! We will eventually change this character into our very own superhero. We will design a new costume, think of a new name and new characteristics. In Maths we will continue to use numbers within 20. We will separate numbers and link this to addition. Our challenge will be to solve addition word problems and add two numbers together.

## Year 1

# Year 2



In Year 2 we have been learning about division. We have been sharing using objects and then solving problems in different ways. Some children have given fantastic explanations of how

they have solved some tricky problems.

#### Year 3

In Year 3, we have been learning about division by sharing into equal groups and by using repeated subtraction. We have continued learning about the rainforest and have been reading 'The Jungle Book' to help us to describe the fearsome Bengal Tiger, Shere Khan. Additionally, we have just started reading our new class book, 'Charlotte's Web' and the children have made some imaginative predictions on what may happen within the story.

#### Year 4

This half term 4A will be writing to persuade our audiences to visit The Pench National Park, which will lead us to debating about deforestation and looking at points for and against. In maths we are securing our knowledge on division and using a formal method to do this.

Year 4H have had a fantastic start to the new term! We have particularly enjoyed our session with our new P.E. coaches, where we are learning lots of fantastic games and teamwork skills.

Both classes are very excited to have 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone' as the class reading book and we can't wait to find out what happens next!

# Year 5

So far, this term has been out of this world for Year 5!! We have had a great time researching planets and the solar system in preparation of our new topic 'Space'. We have been making some wonderful posters too!



# Year 6

This term the Year 6's will be studying the Ancient Greeks and using this topic to inspire our writing. We will be looking at the history and geography of Greece and the impact that the Ancient Greeks have had on the world around us today. In maths we will be continuing with our problem solving approach to our maths work and thinking carefully about how we can explain and justify the mathematical strategies we can use to solve problems.
