

Child Friendly Behaviour Policy



How should we behave and why?

We should behave in a respectful and appropriate way. This means we should be friendly and kind to everyone. We should have pride in our learning and should try hard to make the right choices, always do our best to respect ourselves, each other, and our learning environment.

Our behaviour expectations are BE SAFE, BE RESPECTFUL, BE RESPONSIBLE.

Rewards

We can achieve rewards for following the behaviour expectations and displaying positive learning behaviours.

Rewards can be points, being chosen for celebration assembly, stickers, certificates, prizes, being invited to special events.



What happens if we don't make the right choices?

- **Reminder-** The class will be reminded of the school rules and expectations.
- **C1-** You will be reminded of the expectations and making the right choices. You will miss **5 minutes** of your break time.
- **C2-** Because you have not corrected your behaviour, you will miss **10 minutes** of your break time.
- **C3-** Because you have continued and not corrected your behaviour after C2, you will miss **15 minutes** of your break time and meet with Mrs Taylor .
- **C4-** You will work **out of your class** for **30 minutes** and meet with Mrs Taylor/Miss James. Your teacher will contact your parents.
- **C5 –** You may be suspended - this could be internally or externally.

After each consequence, we will always discuss how we can repair the behaviour. We will always support you to make the right choices.
